

Analysis on Teachers' Feedback (2017-2018)

The questionnaire containing the ten criteria was issued to all Faculty members of all the departments at the end of the academic year 2017 – 2018. Ninety two responses overall from all the departments were obtained through the respective heads. The cumulative responses on satisfaction for each criterion are plotted as a bar diagram. From the plot, it is observed that almost all the criteria are above the level of satisfaction. Many criteria are found to be highly satisfactory. However, in the criteria 2-4 and 7-9, a few responses are observed as neutral/ not satisfactory. Hence, the faculty members who have given negative responses were asked to give their suggestion for the improvement of the teaching-learning process. From their statements, the following scope for improvements has been observed: It is observed that the teachers are expecting enough freedom to suggest the modification of syllabi. Smart Class rooms are expected to be provided for efficient teaching-learning process. Research activities should be encouraged by allocating adequate funds. Journals pertaining to research should be subscribed more in number. Separate library building should be provided.
